



## 5G's E-Safety Code



If you are told to use one website, do not move to another without permission.

When you are on line, get an adult if you see something you do not like.

If you are not sure about a website, ask an adult to check it out for you.

Don't open advertisements as they may contain viruses or messages which are unsuitable for children.

If you receive an unkind text or message, do not reply. Save it and then show a trusted adult.

If you are being bullied on line, don't keep it a secret. Talk to a parent, trusted adult, Childline or the police.

Don't accept friendship requests from people you don't know. They may not be who they say they are.

Do not use your real name. Choose a nickname.

Never give anyone personal information such as your phone number, address or photos of yourself.

Do not pass on bullying messages about someone else.
